Project Updates:

Project 1:

 testing and integration and system acceptance to complete this project from funding
 perspective. This last set of activities will complete the contributions from project 1 in
 regards to the NTIA funds used.

Project 2:

- Meeting scheduled for August 5th with Mr. Ivey and the Swytch Station team in preparation to begin engaging students at the onset of the fall semester.
- Impact to schedule due to the work we're doing to target the NSU veteran students.
- Considering the veteran population of students weren't able to truly benefit from program activities extended to traditional NSU students, we have gathered requirements from the NSU VA Representative, Wayne Ivey to develop a career pathing workshop specifically for the NSU veteran student population.
- What we've developed incorporates the student's military MOS / AFSC (job descriptions), NSU degree curriculum, O'Net (US Department of Labor's occupational online system) and the veteran focused emerging digital platform <u>Swytch Station</u>.
